

Population Demographics:


The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 1,879,489 and changed to 1,974,181 in 2000, representing a change of 5.0%. The household count in 2007 was 1,914,253 and the household projection for 2012 is 1,888,656, a change of -1.3%.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **5,105,071** and in 2000 it was **5,376,741**, roughly a **5.3%** change. The population in 2007 was **5,276,337** and the projection for 2012 is **5,244,278** representing a change of **-0.6%**.

Population by Age




In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was 32.6, and in 2000, it was 33.7. The median age in 2007 is 35.7 and it is predicted to change in five years to 36.9 years. In 2007, females represented 51.4% of the population with a median age of 37.1 and males represented 48.6% of the population with a median age of 34.3 years. In 2007, the most prominent age group in this geography is Age 35 to 44 years. The age group least represented in this geography is 75 + years.


Population by Race/Ethnicity
